RESOLUTION NO. 2009-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DADE CITY, FLORIDA RELATING TO THE STATE REVOLVING FUND LOAN PROGRAM; MAKING FINDINGS; ADOPTING THE WASTEWATER FACILITIES PLAN 2008-2028 AS THE STATE REVOLVING FUND PLANNING DOCUMENT; AND PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS, SEVERABILITY, AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes provide for loans to local government agencies to finance the construction of water pollution control facilities, and

WHEREAS, Florida Administrative Code rules require authorization to approve the Planning Document for financed construction of water pollution control facilities, and

WHEREAS, the State Revolving Fund loan priority list designates Project No. WW67006P as eligible for available funding, and

WHEREAS, the City of Dade City intends to enter into a loan agreement with the Florida Department of Environmental Protection under the State Revolving Fund for project financing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF DADE CITY COMMISSION AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. The foregoing finding are incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof.

SECTION II. The City of Dade City *Wastewater Facilities Plan 2008-2028* is the required State Revolving Fund Planning Document. The Plan presents a comprehensive and coherent plan for the identification and funding of the needed improvements to the City's wastewater infrastructure. The recommendations of the *Wastewater Facilities Plan 2008-2028* are hereby adopted.

SECTION III. Conflicts. All resolutions or part of Resolutions in conflict with any of the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed.

SECTION IV. Severability. If any Section or portion of a Section of this Resolution proves to be invalid, unlawful, or unconstitutional, it shall not be held to invalidate or impair the validity, force or effect of any other Section or part of this Resolution.

SECTION V. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
