AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DADE CITY, FLORIDA, AMENDING SECTIONS 42-31 THROUGH 42-33 OF THE DADE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES TO SUBSTANTIALLY REWRITE REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO NOISE; PROVIDING DEFINITIONS AND FINDINGS; PROVIDING FOR
