

# PROCLAMATION

## *HONORING REVEREND CORA HILL*

**WHEREAS**, on June 26, 1929 John Henry Hill and Austine Hill welcomed the arrival of Cora Hill into their family and the community of Dade City; and

**WHEREAS**, John Henry and Austine Hill had nine other children (five brothers and four sisters to Cora Hill), which surrounded Cora Hill growing up in the Dade City community; and

**WHEREAS**, Cora Hill chose to become an educator and stay in Dade City helping to educate the younger generations, teaching at both the Moore Micken's Academy and Lacoochee Elementary School for a total of 37 successful years; and

**WHEREAS**, there came a time in Cora Hill's life when she felt she could do more with her already blessed life and gave herself to her religion becoming the Reverend Cora Hill; and

**WHEREAS**, in April of 1990 Cora Hill was selected as a member of the Dade City Historic Advisory Board, giving selflessly of her time and energy helping to make decisions that would keep Dade City's history and heritage intact; and

**WHEREAS**, Cora Hill has blessed her family, her friends and her community simply by being 'Cora Hill', and;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Scott Black, Mayor of Dade City, Florida, on behalf of the entire City Commission and citizens of Dade City, do hereby consider it an honor and a privilege to extend this proclamation to **CORA HILL** the occasion of her **80<sup>TH</sup>** birthday, with sincere congratulations and best wishes.
