



Memorandum of Understanding
Between
United Way 2-1-1 of Pasco County
And

City of Dade City

This memorandum describes and documents the working relationship between the United Way 2-1-1 of Pasco County, a program of the United Way of Pasco County and City of Dade City in order to create a seamless information and referral system.

Each party to this memorandum of understanding is a separate and independent organization and nothing herein shall be construed to create a joint venture or legal partnership. Each organization shall retain its own identity in providing services.

The United Way of Pasco County operates the United Way 2-1-1 of Pasco County, a comprehensive information and referral service and maintains a comprehensive database of local government, health and human services. The United Way 2-1-1 of Pasco County service area includes all of Pasco County.

The City of Dade City operates a specialized (governmental) service for (population). The Agency hours of operation are (M-F 8:00am-5:00pm). The Agency service area includes; (City Limits).

If the United Way 2-1-1 of Pasco County receives a call for specialized services in the Agency target population and service area, United Way 2-1-1 of Pasco County will refer the caller to the Agency.

If Agency receives a call that can be better served by a more comprehensive service agency in the United Way 2-1-1 of Pasco County area, the Agency specialist will link the caller to United Way 2-1-1 of Pasco County via referral to United Way 2-1-1 of Pasco County.

Either United Way 2-1-1 of Pasco County or Agency can request dialogue to explore and make changes to this memorandum of understanding as needed.
