

AUGUST 29, 2006
SPECIAL CITY COMMISSION MEETING

The City Commission of Dade City, Florida, met in the City Hall Annex Commission Chambers in a special City Commission meeting on this 29th day of August, A.D. 2006, at 5:00 p.m. The following members were present: Mayor P. Hutchison Brock and Commissioners Scott Black, Camille Hernandez, Eunice Penix and Steve Van Gorden. City staff members present included City Manager Harold R. Sample, City Clerk/Finance Director James D. Class, City Attorney Karla Owens, Police Chief P. A. Thompson, Administrative Services Director Laura Beagles, Safety Services Director J. P. Wubbena and Executive Assistant Chris Chandler.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor P. H. Brock, and invocation was given by City Clerk James D. Class, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to The Flag.

The purpose of this meeting was consideration of a resolution to declare a local state of emergency for the anticipated Tropical Storm Ernesto. Resolution No. 2006-0914 was read by title only by the City Clerk, as follows:

Commissioner Black moved approval of Resolution No. 2006-0914. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Van Gorden, and on a vote the motion passed unanimously.
