


MAY 30, 2007
CITY COMMISSION WORKSHOP

The City Commission of Dade City, Florida, met in the City Hall Annex Commission Chambers in a workshop on this 30th day of March A.D. 2007, at 6:05 p.m. The following members were present: Mayor P. H. Brock and Commissioners Camille Hernandez, Eunice Penix, Scott Black, and Steve Van Gorden. City staff members present included City Manager Harold R. Sample, City Clerk/Finance Director James D.
