CITY COMMISSION WORKSHOP

The City Commission of Dade City, Florida, met in the City Hall Annex Commission Chambers in a workshop on this 23rd day of October, 2007, at 3:42 p.m. The following members were present: Mayor P. H. Brock and Commissioners Eunice Penix, Scott Black, and Steve Van Gorden. Commissioner Camille Hernandez was absent. City staff members present included Interim City Manager and City Clerk/Finance Director James D. Class and City Attorney Karla Owens.

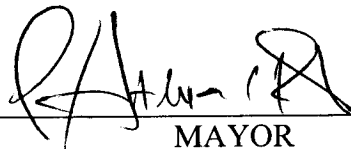
The workshop was called to order by Mayor P. H. Brock.

The purpose of the workshop was to discuss the proposed revisions to the city charter.

After discussion, the Commission suggested changes to the proposed charter, including:

- adding language to the preamble regarding the county seat and the city slogan,
- noting that action of the Commission requires three votes,
- making references to state law general instead of specific throughout the charter,
- removing the requirements of holding Commission meetings on different days from the County Commission and keeping digital minutes,
- removing language regarding the residency of the city manager,
- changing language regarding the appointment of the city clerk and finance officer,
- removing the section relating to Commission districting, and
- removing the section relating to recall, initiative, and citizen referendum and replacing it with a general reference to state law.

There being no further business before the Commission, on motion the workshop adjourned at 5:16 p.m.
