The City Commission of Dade City, Florida, met in the City Hall Annex Commission Chambers in a special City Commission meeting on this 3rd day of December, 2007, at 4:42 p.m. The following members were present: Mayor P. H. Brock and Commissioners Camille Hernandez, Eunice Penix, Scott Black, and Steve Van Gorden. City staff members present included Interim City Manager and City Clerk/Finance Director James D. Class and Administrative Services Director Laura Beagles.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor P. H. Brock, followed by the invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance to The Flag.


The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the City Manager selection and topics for the upcoming Pasco County legislative delegation meeting.
