CITY COMMISSION WORKSHOP


The City Commission of Dade City, Florida, met in the City Hall Annex Commission Chambers in a workshop on this 8th day of January, 2008, at 4:12 p.m. The following members were present: Mayor P. H. Brock and Commissioners Eunice Penix, Scott Black, Steve Van Gorden, and Camille Hernandez. City staff members present included Interim City Manager and City Clerk/Finance Director James D. Class, Deputy City Clerk Joanna Akers, and City Attorney Karla Owens.

The workshop was called to order by Mayor P. H. Brock.

The purpose of the workshop was to discuss the proposed Citrus Ridge development. City Attorney Karla Owens reviewed the proposed development and distributed, to the Commission, an additional e-mail she received this afternoon. After discussion, it was the recommendation of the Commission to authorize staff to draft a memo to the County with the supporting exhibits and information that was addressed. In addition, it was the consensus of the Commission to send Commissioner Black and City Attorney Karla Owens, as our representatives, to the DRC meeting scheduled on January 24th.
