

MAY 27, 2008
CITY COMMISSION WORKSHOP

The City Commission of Dade City, Florida, met in the City Hall Annex Commission Chambers in a workshop on this 27th day of May, 2008, at 4:29 p.m. The following members were present: Mayor Scott Black and Commissioners Steve Van Gorden, Eunice Penix, Curtis Beebe, and Camille Hernandez. City staff members present included City Manager William C. Poe, Jr., City Clerk/Finance Director James D. The workshop was called to order by Mayor Black.

After discussion, the following is a list of the top five (5) Capital Projects and top five (5) Procedures/Processes:


Capital Projects

- (1) W/S Utility Infrastructure improvements, including expansion of Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP).
- (2) Youth/Community Center
- (3) Sidewalks and Paving Dirt Roads
- (4) Parking Downtown
- (5) Extension of the Hardy Trail

Procedures/Processes


- (1) Organizational Structure of City Hall, including Performance Evaluation/Citizen Survey/Updating City Website.
- (2) Tracking System for Projects & Contracts and Status Report.
- (3) Grants
- (4) Partnering/Outsourcing
- (5) Economic Development & Incentives/Sustainable Practices – "Green".

There being no further business before the Commission, on motion the workshop adjourned at 5:25 p.m.
