CITY COMMISSION WORKSHOP


The City Commission of Dade City, Florida, met in the City Hall Annex Commission Chambers in a workshop on this 22nd day of June, 2008, at 4:12 p.m. The following members were present: Mayor Scott Black and Commissioners Steve Van Gorden, Curtis Beebe, and Camille Hernandez. Commissioner Penix arrived at 4:30 p.m. City staff members present included City Manager William C. Poe, Jr., City Clerk/Finance Director James D. Class, Deputy City Clerk Joanna Akers, Police Chief Raymond Velboom, and Development Review Technician Karen Traenkner. City Attorney Karla Owens arrived at 5:00 p.m.

The workshop was called to order by Mayor Black.

The purpose of this workshop was to discuss Land Use Guidelines. Karen Traenkner, Development Review Technician, noted the memorandum from City Attorney Karla Owens and reviewed the approved development projects in Dade City. (The complete memorandum is on file in the City Clerk's office.)


