CITY COMMISSION WORKSHOP

The City Commission of Dade City, Florida, met in the City Hall Annex Commission Chambers in a workshop on this 24th day of March, 2009, at 4:05 p.m. The following members were present: Mayor Scott Black and Commissioners Steve Van Gorden, Camille Hernandez, Curtis Beebe, and Eunice Penix. City staff members present included City Manager William C. Poe, Jr., City Clerk/Finance Director James D. Class, and City Attorney Karla Owens.

The workshop was called to order by Mayor Black.

The purpose of the workshop was to discuss the potential impacts of the proposed changes to the CSX rail line. Donald Skelton, from the Department of Transportation, provided an introduction to the discussion. Bob O'Malley, from the CSX Corporation, discussed the proposed Sunrail legislation, the potential train counts through Dade City, and the proposed improvements to the rail line.
