

AUGUST 4, 2009
CITY COMMISSION WORKSHOP

The City Commission of Dade City, Florida, met in the City Hall Annex Commission Chambers in a workshop on this 4th day of August, 2009, at 5:40 p.m. The following members were present: Mayor Scott Black and Commissioners Steve Van Gorden, Camille Hernandez, Curtis Beebe, and Eunice Penix. City staff members present included City Manager William C. Poe, Jr., City Clerk/Finance Director James D. Class, and Police Chief Raymond Velboom.

The workshop was called to order by Mayor Black. After a moment of silence in memory of Leola Thinn, Mayor Black gave an invocation, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

The purpose of the workshop was to review the draft budget for fiscal year 2009-2010. City Manager William Poe gave an overview of the budget, followed by discussion and questions from the Commission regarding the department budgets. After discussion, it was the consensus of the Commission to shift \$2,000 from Youth Council and Commission expenditures to provide funding for Sunrise and Habitat for Humanity. The Commission also requested information on building permits and inspections and want more financial information from the Chamber and Main Street for their contributions.

With no further business before the Commission, on motion the workshop adjourned at 7:25 p.m.
