CITY COMMISSION WORKSHOP

The City Commission of Dade City, Florida, met in the City Hall Annex Commission Chambers in a workshop on this 8th day of July, 2010, at 5:42 p.m. The following members were present: Mayor Scott Black and Commissioners Curtis Beebe, William Dennis, Camille Hernandez, and Eunice Penix.
