CITY COMMISSION WORKSHOP


The City Commission of Dade City, Florida, met in the City Hall Annex Commission Chambers in a workshop on this 22nd day of February, 2011, at 4:12 p.m. The following members were present: Mayor Scott Black and Commissioners Curtis Beebe, William Dennis, Camille Hernandez, and Eunice Penix.
