

JUNE 28, 2011
CITY COMMISSION WORKSHOP

The City Commission of Dade City, Florida, met in the City Hall Annex Commission Chambers in a workshop on this 28th day of June, 2011, at 4:13 p.m. The following members were present: Mayor Scott Black and Commissioners Curtis Beebe, William Dennis, Camille Hernandez, and Eunice Penix. City staff members present included City Manager William C. Poe, Jr., City Clerk/Finance Director James D. Class, City Attorney Karla Owens, Police Chief Raymond Velboom, and City Engineer/Public Works Director Lennie Naeyaert.

The workshop was called to order by Mayor Black.

The purpose of the workshop was a discussion of the priorities for the fiscal year 2011-2012 budget.

After discussion, it was the consensus of the Commission that the top five priorities for the 2011-2012 budget, not in ranked order, would be water system improvements, stormwater improvements, street paving and resurfacing, increased code enforcement, and facilities for police accreditation. Long-term goals mentioned included a community center, city hall, water facilities, street paving, and canal maintenance.

With no further business before the Commission, the workshop was adjourned at 5:21 p.m.
