



Florida law now requires Mold Remediation contractors to be licensed by the Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulation

(Chapter 468, Part XVI of the Florida Statutes and Rule 61-31 of the Florida Administrative Code.)

Florida is one of only 5 states to regulate the mold remediation industry!

- **The new law mandates that all individuals and corporations performing mold assessment and/or remediation to be properly licensed through the Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulation and regulated under a new Mold Licensing Board.**
 - **A mold remediator must maintain a general liability insurance policy in an amount of not less than \$1,000,000 that includes specific coverage for mold-related claims.**
- **Mold remediation to a structure cannot be performed by the mold assessor that provided a mold assessment for said structure within the last 12 months.**
